All prospective applicants must comply with the following requirements:

- Students must be registered within the Faculty of Law of the University of Namibia;
- All applicants must have at least two semesters to complete for graduation to be eligible for election to the Board of Editors;
- All candidates for Editorial positions must have an average of not less than 60% for the duration of their time in Faculty of Law;
- All applications must include a *Curriculum Vitae* and original academic record (or certified copies thereof) of the candidate;

- Candidates should provide a one page motivational letter, motivating why they should be considered for the positions applied for.
